Let's make our State Circle the BEST IN THE NATION.

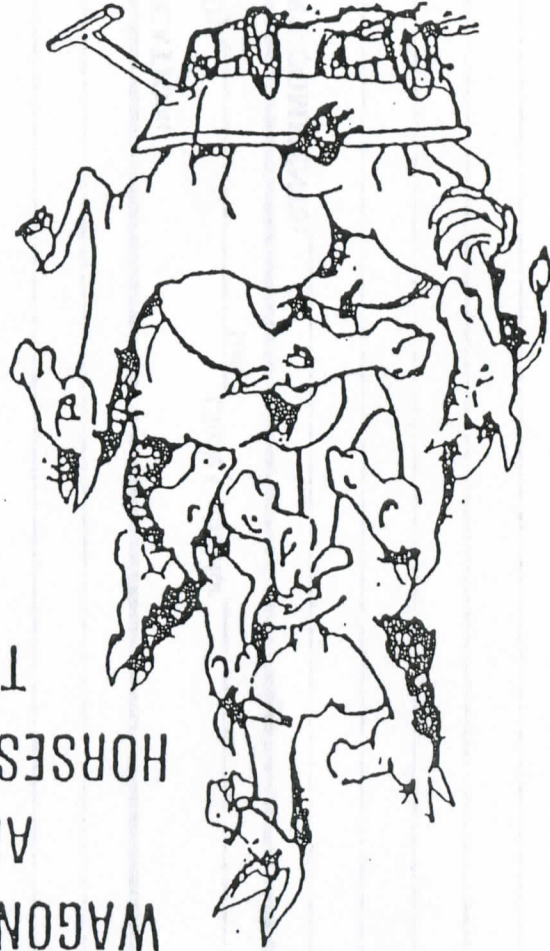
